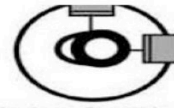

Venaseal Closure Pre-Treatment instructions :

Take a shower in the morning. Sedation is not necessary for this procedure.

If sedation is planned, please have someone accompany you to drive you home.

Venaseal Closure Post-Treatment instructions:

If you receive sedation during the procedure, rest at home for several hours

Return to normal activities

Refrain from strenuous activities: 2 days

Pain medication: as directed by the physician

No need to wear compression stockings.

Ambulation instructions: Brisk walk 90 minutes a day for 2 days

Remove dressing after: 2 days

Follow-up visit: in 3 to 5 days

It is normal to experience some tenderness and possible bruising in the areas where local anesthesia was administered.

Call your physician immediately if you experience any of the following:

- Prolonged tenderness, redness or warmth along the treated segment
- Moderate to severe pain, preventing return to normal activities
- Shortness of breath
